### NURSERY SCHOOL

### LATE -PICK UP POLICY

It is important to be familiar with all daycare policies and that includes our late-pick up policy. Please be sure to pick up your child(ren) on time each night. The daycare hours are: 7:15am to 6:00pm. Any children picked up after 6:00pm will result in a late fee. The staff does not get paid after 6:00pm, all late pick-up fees are paid directly to the staff at time of pick up. The Daycare recently has been having a very difficult time with late pick up. At this time we have over 15 families owing late payment fees. If you are owing a late fee payment please pay it immediately. All outstanding late fees will be submitted to the Board of Directors and those parents will be asked to attend the next Board meeting to discuss payment. A copy of the late fee policy is posted on top of the sign-in/out desk.

### BOARD MEETING INFO

At this year's Annual General Meeting a new Board of Director's was formed. Once a month the members of this board will meet to discuss the function of the daycare and all issues pertaining to its operation. All daycare parents are welcomed to

attend a board meeting and share their ideas and concerns or simply to come out and listen. Our next board meeting will be Wednesday, September 26, 2007 at 6:00pm.

**SHARING INFORMATION** (for all children attending Garden Ave. Public School)

A blue form is being passed out for all parents to read and sign. This form gives the daycare teachers permission to exchange information pertaining to their child with the school teachers at Garden Avenue School. As professionals ongoing communication is key to maintaining a positive working and learning environment. Please be sure to get and sign for a consent form from one of the daycare staff. If you have any questions or concerns about this form then please feel free to ask.

We are just on the cusp of changing seasons and the weather is starting to cool down a bit. Please dress your children appropriately each day for daycare especially for outdoor play. Also please make sure that your child has an extra set of clothing at daycare each day for accidents and an extra pair of shoes.
