

MY BLUEPRINT

My Blueprint can be used to:

- Set short and long term goals and plan for the future
- Plan courses for secondary school
- Discover what post-secondary programs are available to you based on your secondary school choices
- Explore what secondary school choices and programs are out there
- Explore various careers and job opportunities and find out what kind of training is required for each and what kind of money you can make
- Save all your information as you will have your own account

Existing Users:

- 1) Go to the green existing users box to the left of the screen
- 2) Enter your e-mail and password
- 3) Proceed with what you would like to do!

First time users:

- 1) Go to the blue new users box on the left hand side of the screen
- 2) Select the high school that you are going to in Gr. 9 or that you have an interest in.

Please note: The high school selection can be changed anytime. You are not “locked” in once you have chosen.

3) Click “Create Account”

4) Enter the information it is asking you for. Don’t forget your password! This is what you will use to log in the next time. Click on “Start using my blueprint”.

5) As you scroll down, stop to explore the various aspects of the site by clicking to open them up (Goal Setting, High School Planning, Extra Curricular etc...)

6) Notice the blue bar at the top that has “My Profile” “High-School Planner” and “Post Secondary Planner”. FYI - Clicking “My Profile” will always take you back to the original screen with all the various tabs.

7) Click Post Secondary Planner- Notice all the tabs you can choose to find out information about college, university and apprenticeships. To find out about a particular program you can click on “Program Finder”. To find out about careers you can click on “Occupation Finder”.

Activity:

- 1) Click on "Occupation Finder". Use the pre-set pull down menu items to choose an area or leave them as "All" and type in your own specific career.
- 2) Scroll through the list it gives you and click on one of interest. Notice all the info about that career it gives you. If you want to keep the info click on "Save to Profile" at the top or bottom right hand side of the screen and click "OK".
- 3) Now click my profile and scroll down to "Saved Occupations". You should this occupation saved there.
- 4) Start a new search the same way by using the blue bar along the top "Post Secondary Planner" and then click "Occupation Finder".

Extension: You can do the same with programs of interest as well. Find a program of interest and save it to your profile.

Want more to do?

Check out the "Goal Setting" and "High School Planning" tabs where you can create course plans base on your end goals. For example, if your plan is to go to college, you can enter this and it will suggest what your course choices should be. You can create and save more than one plan to compare.
